The Oswego County Health Department will be holding a 2009 H1N1 influenza vaccine clinic for children who attend schools in the Phoenix Central School District.

- WHEN?** • Tuesday, January 5, 2010 from 4:00 PM to 7:00 PM by appointment.
- WHERE?** • Michael A. Maroun Elementary School cafeteria.
- WHO?** • Only school staff and children attending school in the Phoenix School District will be vaccinated.
- WHAT?** • The vaccine—either the nasal mist or injectable type—will be administered based on which type is appropriate.
- COST?** • The vaccination and the vaccine are free.
- HOW?** • To get an appointment, starting December 28,

- call 349-3572 between 8:30 AM and 4:00 PM
- Please complete the consent form, except your signature, and bring to the clinic.
 - You will receive vaccine information sheets at the clinic.
 - You will sign the consent form at the clinic
